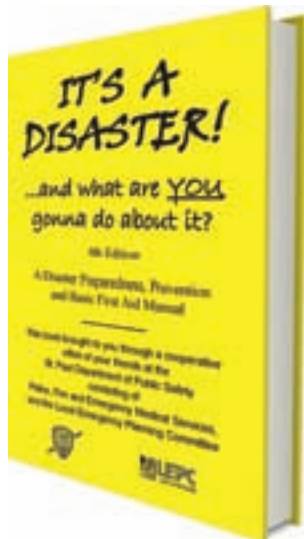




Manning the Waterfront
